## **EVENT IMPACT**

Hosting yet another sold out crowd, the 2023 Winter Ball brought in more than \$200,000 to benefit the Marshall Cancer Care Center which celebrated its 10th Anniversary in July.

The numbers tell the story. Since the "Closer to Home" campaign raised \$3 million and broke ground on the 2-story, 22,000 square-foot facility with its tall glass atrium and the latest technology built in, the Marshall Cancer Care Center has treated more than 126,000 patients, administered more than 100,000 infusion medicines and delivered more than 44,000 radiation treatments. The number of employees has doubled in a decade and physicians have increased from three to five.

Nothing, however, resounds as loudly as the patients' own words when they share their experience such as the one highlighted above.

### **EVENT IMPACT**

The 2023 Women's Health Luncheon built on the excitement of the previous year as one of the most well attended events hosted at the Guntersville City Harbor Event Center. With over 280 women in attendance overlooking Lake Guntersville, funds raised topped \$38,000 while guests enjoyed lunch, our "Bring Home the Bag" drawing, an informative healthcare panel and hilarious keynote from comedian, Lisa Mills.

Funds raised allowed the Foundation to purchase four infant ventilators for the Labor & Delivery departments at Marshall Medical Centers North and South. These ventilators improve Marshall Medical Center's ability to provide excellence in care, and allow our Pediatric Care Team more confidence when caring for our critical newborns.

### **EVENT IMPACT**

The 2023 Pink Pumpkin Run was themed "Pink on Parade" with hundreds of people out in force under blue skies to run for a cause.

Proceeds from the event reached over \$50,000 and funds Marshall Medical's Mammography Assistance Program. Through this program, 3D mammograms are given free of charge to indigent women in Marshall County giving them a 41% higher chance of detecting breast cancer in the early stages.

More than 5,000 women have received a mammogram thanks to this program and the support the Pink Pumpkin Run receives each year.




